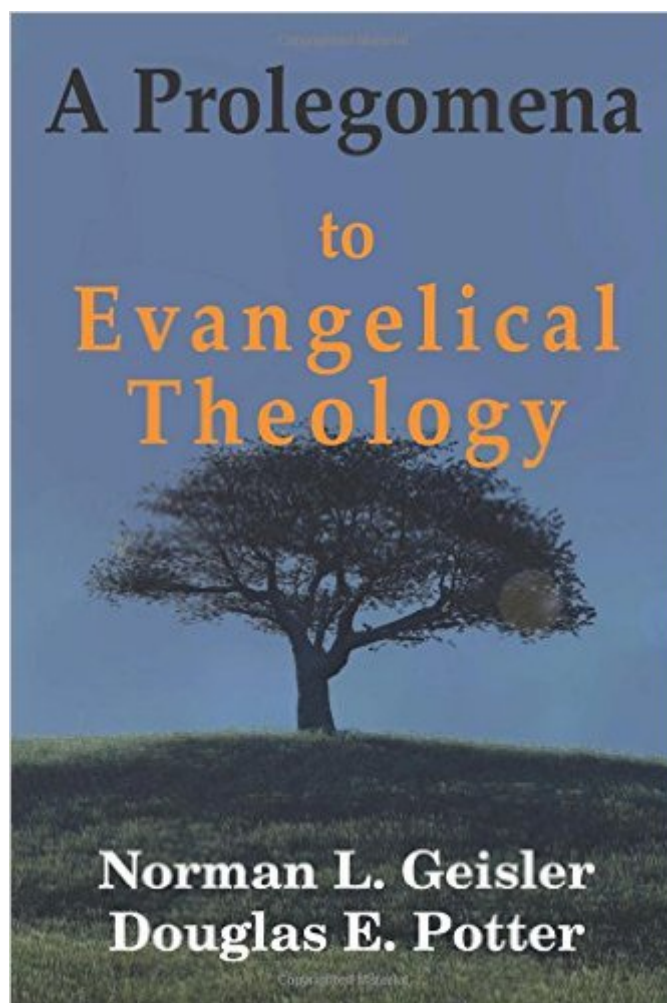


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A Prolegomena To Evangelical Theology



Synopsis

This is a defense of evangelical theology for the beginning student. It certainly is also a primer for students already familiar with theology.
