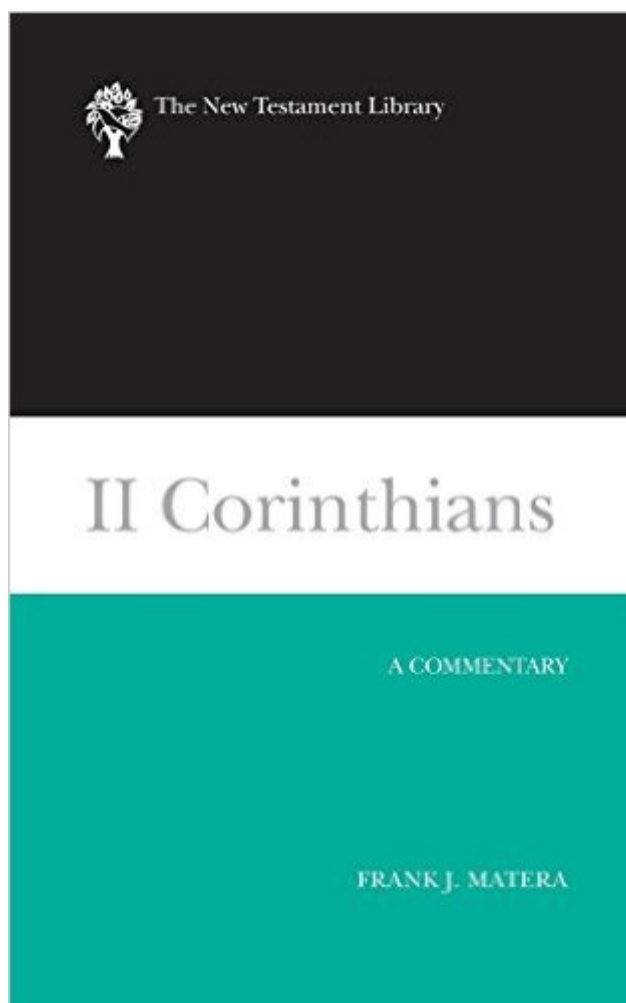


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II Corinthians (2003): A Commentary (New Testament Library)
